Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

1. Survey participants must be aged 18 years or over.
2. Entry to the prize draw is only open to survey participants who reside within Australia. Australian Indigenous HealthInfoNet staff and their immediate families are ineligible to enter.
3. The survey and associated prize draw close at 11.59pm AWST on Sunday 21 August 2022.
4. Entrants in the prize draw must complete the survey and entry form during the survey period (Monday 1 August 2022 to Sunday 21 August 2022).
5. Entrants must provide a valid email address and/or phone contact number at the completion of the survey.
6. Participants may only complete the survey and enter the prize draw once* (*two entries will be automatically created for first week entrants).
7. The prize draw will take place on Thursday 25 August 2022.
8. The winners will be chosen at random.
9. The winners be notified by email and/or phone within 24 hours of the draw.
10. In the event that a winner does not respond to contact within 14 days, a new winner will be drawn.
11. The winners' names will be announced on the Australian Indigenous HealthInfoNet Alcohol and Other Drugs Knowledge Centre (AODKC) website in a news item within 30 days of the draw.
